

I AM. . . HOLY SPIRIT WHO HOVERS OVER THE CHAOS

I. Welcome and Worship, Holy God:

Playlists: Just As I AM Instrumentals

I AM . . . the Spirit Who Hovers

Ideally, it would be a wonderful, breezy day for the time of this study and the windows of the house could be open for everyone to feel the breeze waft in and around them. If not, try to have an oscillating fan or ceiling fan *gently* sweeping its breeze over the group during the worship period. Do not worry about the sound because no words need to be heard, as today's worship needs to be entirely instrumental.

III. Ponder and Proclaim:

Note this: the same word used in Genesis 1 for *hovered* is the exact word used in Deuteronomy 32:11 to describe the caring, protective guidance of the eagle for her young!

1. What are the implications of the expanded meaning when those two passages are linked?

The Hebrew word for the Spirit (*ruach*) translates to *wind breath*. Think of examples in your life where God has revealed Himself as *breath*. **2. What are some examples from real life where wind or movement of air brings life?** (Take time to explore this.)

3. Now, in what areas of your life does chaos reign?

4. Are you willing to ask the Holy Spirit to hover of those areas of chaos?

5. Finally, are you willing to believe that He can and will bring life from that chaos? 6. Why?

IV. Pray and Praise:

Close by reading the poem, *Hover Over Me*, p. 41. Then begin praising prayer by asking God to reveal Himself in your life as the Holy Spirit. Continue by thanking Him that He will reveal Himself beautifully and powerfully, because that is exactly what He desires to do! Celebrate this: from the very beginning of time, He was willing to hover over chaos and to bring forth life from it. Yield to Him the chaos of your life; ask Him to hover over it and create meaning, purpose, and life. Thank Him that He is there.

Finally - -if possible, *Go fly a kite!* ☺
